- Make sure you credit card will work internationally.
- Consider leaving valuable jewelry at home.
- Consider packing light to allow room for merchandise from Jamaica.

- Passport (Required)
- Pack light

- Bug repellent (with DEET)
- Cash for tips
- Medicine (Recommended in your carry-on luggage.)
- Resort Casual Clothes (This is the Hilton Rose Hall's dress code for dinner.)
- Swimwear
- Sunglasses
- Phone Charger
- Book for the children of Howard Cooke Primary School (Community Service)
